Characteristics of Natural Birch Wood

Birch is a primary species in the Echelon Cabinets product portfolio. The sapwood is greenish white, sometimes with darker colored mineral characteristics. The heartwood varies from light to dark, reddish brown. The wood is often straight-grained with a fine uniform texture but can also come in wavy or curly patterns. This natural character graining is inherent in the Echelon Cabinets product and is not considered a defect but rather the natural beauty of the wood itself. Because this is the characteristic of natural birch, Echelon Cabinets cannot accept responsibility of the inherent properties of wood and wood products.
