Cherry is a primary species in the Echelon Cabinets product portfolio. The wood is usually pinkish brown in color, but can go to shades of off-white, green and even gray. Sapwood is white to yellowish; heartwood is deep reddish brown. The wood is medium weight with a close, fine grain. This natural character graining is inherent in the Echelon Cabinets product and is not considered a defect but rather the natural beauty of the wood itself. Because this is the characteristic of cherry, Echelon Cabinets cannot accept responsibility of the inherent properties of wood and wood products.
