Characteristics of Natural Maple Wood

Our finishing materials and application methods utilize the latest coating technology and time-tested techniques that consider the variables of wood and environmental conditions in which our product is manufactured and ultimately used.

Maple is a primary species in the Echelon Cabinets product portfolio and is used in hard and soft maple wood. Natural Maple in most respects is very similar to hard maple. The sapwood is grayish white, sometimes with darker colored mineral characteristics. The heartwood varies from light to dark reddish brown. The wood grain is fine, tight-closed grain with some flecking evident and is moderately hard and strong. This natural character graining is inherent in the Echelon product and is not considered a defect but rather the natural beauty of the wood itself. Because this is the characteristic of natural maple, Echelon Cabinets cannot accept responsibility of the inherent properties of wood and wood products.
