Characteristics of Rustic Alder Wood

Our finishing materials and application methods utilize the latest coating technology and time-tested techniques that consider the variables of wood and environmental conditions in which our product is manufactured and ultimately used.

Rustic Alder is a primary species in the Echelon Cabinets product portfolio. The wood is light tan to reddish brown. It has a similar appearance to birch, though alder is slightly redder. There is no visible distinction between heartwood and sapwood. Alder generally has a moderately fine, uniform texture; the knotty grades have visible knots and pinholes adding to the character. This natural character graining and knotting is inherent in the Echelon Cabinets product and is not considered a defect but rather the natural beauty of the wood itself. Because this is the characteristic of rustic alder, Echelon Cabinets cannot accept responsibility of the inherent properties of wood and wood products.
